



# AHEC Community Health Scholars Program

## What is the AHEC Community Health Scholars Program?

The AHEC Community Health Scholars Program is a 1-year program that enables high-potential medical assistants to explore primary care with an emphasis on community health and interdisciplinary practice in medically under-resourced communities.

## Who is eligible?

1. Medical Assistants who are starting their technical program.
2. Other allied health students admitted on a case by case basis.

## What are the program requirements?

1. Complete a minimum of 40 hours of didactic learning per year.
2. Complete a minimum of 140 hours of experiential learning at a CCALAC member health center.

\*Health center placement is facilitated by CCALAC program manager\*

## Is this opportunity paid?

The program provides a yearly stipend that varies upon the availability of funds.
