

# AHEC Community Health Scholars Program

### What is the AHEC Community Health Scholars Program?

The AHEC Community Health Scholars Program is a 1-year program that enables high-potential medical assistants to explore primary care with an emphasis on community health and interdisciplinary practice in medically under-resourced communities.

## Who is eligible?

- 1. Medical Assistants who are starting their technical program.
- 2. Other allied health students admitted on a case by case basis.

### What are the program requirements?

- 1. Complete a minimum of 40 hours of didactic learning per year.
- 2. Complete a minimum of 140 hours of experiential learning at a CCALAC member health center.

## Is this opportunity paid?

The program provides a yearly stipend that varies upon the availability of funds.
