### One year scholars:

### Two year scholars:

- 80 hours of online modules
- 80 hours of community-based, experiential and/or clinical hours (hours obtained for degree program can be used)
- community project

- Behavioral Health Services
- Social Determinants of Health
- Cultural Competency
- Practice Transformation
- Current and Emerging Health Issues
