## Program Overview

AltaMed is one of many Area Health Education Centers (AHEC) across the state of California. The AltaMed-East Los Angeles AHEC focuses on training and development of future health care professionals in providing care to the communities we serve. AHEC Scholars will obtain certification from the CA AHEC Program Office and a yearly stipend upon completion of program requirements. The AHEC Scholars program provides a self-paced and hybrid supplemental learning experience for students within the following areas:

- **Non-degree allied healthcare programs (pending eligibility)**
- **Community Health Worker**
- **Public Health (Undergraduate)**
- **Nursing**
- **Masters of Social Work (MSW)**
- **Masters of Public Health (MPH)**
- **Psychology (Graduate only)**
- **Physician Assistant**

## Program Requirements:

-  2-year or 1-year commitment depending on academic program level.\*
-  40 hours of didactic learning each year.
-  40 hours of clinical based hours.
-  Community-based Health Project.

\*Undergraduate and Graduate programs follow two year plans.
